

Breeding Conditions for Quineus GNZ for the Current Breeding Season.

New Zealand breeding season runs each year from the 1st of September to the 31st March. This contract covers Fresh and Frozen Semen from Quineus GNZ.

**Quineus GNZ** is a modern sport horse sire standing at **170cm**, admired for his scope, carefulness, and confidence over fences. He combines refinement, correct conformation, and natural athleticism, making him ideally suited to producing the next generation of competitive athletes.

Known for his excellent jumping technique and expressive form, Quineus GNZ crosses particularly well with both New Zealand-bred mares and imported European bloodlines, consistently producing foals that inherit his balance of performance and elegance.

Descended from proven, enduring bloodlines that continue to deliver international success, Quineus GNZ represents a valuable addition to any forward-thinking breeding program. His progeny are eligible for registration with the New Zealand Hanoverian Society.

## **Fees for Fresh Semen**

The service for Quineus GNZ is \$1700 + gst. LFG + collection costs.

- 1. Upon accepting this agreement, a non-refundable booking fee of \$700 plus gst NZD is due. This will nominate the mare named on this contract you have completed here online.
- 2. You will be sent an Invoice from Thompson Performance Horses and once the booking fee is paid Thompson Performance Horses will make Quineus GNZ available, whenever possible to be collected for your nominated mare, until she is pregnant.
- 3. If he is not available when you require semen you may be offered frozen semen in place of fresh semen.
- 4. You must give a minimum of 3 days' notice when ordering a fresh semen collection.
- 5. There may be times when Quineus GNZ is available for a set time frame and it is advisable to check these times so you can plan your mares breeding then.
- 6. All collection and shipping costs must be paid at the time of collection to CryNZ.
- 7. Semen must **only** be used on the nominated mare.
- 8. All documents accompanying the semen must be completed by the Vet or Al technician at the time of the insemination and returned to CryNZ.

## **Conditions of Use**

- 1. The semen must be used only on the marenominated in this contract. This is the mare listed on the online booking form.
- 2. The semen handling and inseminations must be performed by an approved Veterinarian or an approvedA.I technician.
- 3. All documents accompanying the semen must be completed and returned to CryNZ after each insemination with the empty straws.
- 4. The semen dose rate will accompany all shipments of Quineus GNZ's semen. The dose rate must be adhered to and all straws to be used in each dose. No splitting of doses.
- 5. The use of semen for ICSI is not allowed.
- 6. If the mare is for embryo transfer, this must be stated at time of booking and notified to Thompson Performance Horses or CryNZ.
- 7. If for any reason it becomes necessary for QuineusGNZ to be Gelded, then only Frozen semen will be available to complete LFG. For the time restrictions explained in the LFG guidelines.
- 8. If your mare becomes unsuitable for breeding after the contract is agreed on. You may be able to negotiate to nominate a second mare or postpone the breeding until the next season only. This is only available on an individual basis.

## **LFG Conditions**

The Live Foal guarantee is only available once the Full Service fee is paid \$1,700 + gst.

- The Live Foal guarantee is available for a total of two breeding seasons following the date of the initial booking. This means the current breeding season and the following year.
- This means you may return your mare for breeding to Quineus GNZ if your mare slips the
  pregnancy after the Full service fee of \$1700 +gst is paid. Or the foal dies before it is 24
  hours old.
- If your mare does not conceive after the booking fee is paid you may return your mare the following seasononly without paying the booking fee again.
- Veterinary notice of all these instances will be required.
